UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

SUBJECT: Paul Hughes (U)

1. (S) An uncarded and untested ACSI source, a Commandante in the Cuban Rebel Army, reported on 26 February 1959 that Captain Paul Hughes left for Oriente Province on 19 February on a classified Army Air mission, probably in connection with the invasion of Hispanola Island.
2. (S) An ACSI field representative spoke to Paul Hughes in the Hilton Hotel on the evening of 27 February 1959. Hughes claimed he had just returned from visiting his wife and family in Georgia and had resolved his difficulties with the FBI concerning his stock of rifles and ammunition there.
