6 THE PROBATION OFFICER: MS. DONAHUE WITH PROBATION.

7 THE COURT: MS. NAPOLIS, ARE YOU HERE?

8 THE PROBATIONER: YES, SIR.

9 THE COURT: GOOD MORNING. IF WE KEEP MEETING LIKE
10 THIS, PEOPLE ARE GOING TO START TALKING.

11 THE PROBATIONER: I KNOW, SIR. YOUR HONOR, I HAVE A
12 WITNESS BY THE NAME OF DR. HELEN LACHTER (PHONETIC). SHE
13 JUST WANTED TO SAY A FEW WORDS.

14 THE COURT: ABOUT WHAT?

15 THE PROBATIONER: I'M -- AT THIS POINT I'M NOT EVEN
16 REALLY SURE WHAT IS GOING TO HAPPEN. I'M YET TO BE INFORMED
17 OF WHAT THE EXACT ALLEGATIONS ARE, SO I GUESS IN TERMS OF
18 FROM WHAT I KNOW SO FAR, IT APPEARS THAT SOMEONE IS TRYING
19 TO INFRINGE ON MY RIGHT TO FREE SPEECH. I'M NOT DOING
20 ANYTHING ILLEGALLY. DR. HELEN LACHTER HAS LETTERS FROM
21 OTHER PEOPLE, PROFESSIONALS IN THE UNITED STATES WHO AGREE
22 WITH DR. HELEN LACHTER. SHE'S KNOWN ME FOR TEN YEARS, AND
23 SO SHE WANTED TO MAKE A FEW STATEMENTS ABOUT THAT.

24 THE COURT: OKAY.

25 I'M NOT QUITE SURE WHY WE'RE HERE, SO WHY DON'T
26 YOU, MS. DONAHUE, TELL ME WHAT THIS IS ALL ABOUT.

27 THE PROBATION OFFICER: SURE THING. PROBATION
28 RECEIVED INFORMATION FROM SEVERAL INDIVIDUALS THAT WITH

1 RESPECT TO MS. NAPOLIS, SHE POSTED ON WEBSITES MALICIOUS AND
2 INFLAMMATORY INFORMATION THAT MAY LEAD TO THEIR HARM.

3 THE COURT: HARM? THAT'S THEIR OPINION?

4 THE PROBATION OFFICER: THAT IS RIGHT. WHILE THEY ARE
5 NOT SPECIFIC VICTIMS IN MS. NAPOLIS' CASE, THE PEOPLE
6 ALLEGED THAT THE PERPETRATOR UTILIZED TECHNOLOGY TO
7 VICTIMIZE HER.

8 PROBATION IS CONCERNED -- PROBATION HAS
9 RECEIVED INFORMATION -- IT'S MY OBLIGATION AS A COURT
10 OFFICER TO REPORT TO -- TO THE COURT THAT -- THAT'S MERELY
11 WHAT WE'RE DOING IS REPORTING TO THE COURT FOR INFORMATION
12 ONLY. PROBATION IS NOT ALLEGING ANY ALLEGATIONS OF -- OF
13 VIOLATION AT THIS TIME; IT'S JUST AN INFORMATIONAL TO THE
14 COURT.

15 THE COURT: OKAY. SO YOU'RE NOT SEEKING A REVOCATION?

16 THE PROBATION OFFICER: NO, I'M NOT SEEKING
17 REVOCATION.

18 THE COURT: OKAY.

19 ANYTHING YOU WANT TO SAY, MS. SOLOV?

20 MS. SOLOV: NO, YOUR HONOR.

21 THE COURT: OKAY.

22 SO THEY'RE TELLING ME YOU'RE POSTING THINGS
23 THAT SOME PEOPLE ARE FINDING OFFENSIVE. THEY'RE NOT SEEKING
24 A REVOCATION. SO WHILE SOME PEOPLE DON'T PARTICULARLY LIKE
25 WHAT YOU'RE WRITING ABOUT AND WHETHER OR NOT THERE IS ANY
26 ACTIONABLE LAWSUITS OR ANYTHING FROM THOSE PEOPLE AGAINST
27 YOU IS REALLY NOT MY CONCERN; I'M ONLY CONCERNED WITH
28 WHETHER YOU'RE VIOLATING PROBATION. APPARENTLY PROBATION

1 DOES NOT THINK SO, SO I DON'T REALLY KNOW WHAT YOU WANT ME
2 TO DO. YOUR TURN.

3 THE PROBATIONER: I AGREE. I HAVE FILED A FEDERAL
4 LAWSUIT AND I HAVE MADE ALLEGATIONS IN THIS LAWSUIT WHICH I
5 KNOW IS A PUBLIC RECORD, THE CASE HAS NOT BEEN SEALED OR
6 ANYTHING LIKE THAT, AND WHAT I'VE BEEN DOING ON THE INTERNET
7 IS TALKING ABOUT THE ALLEGATIONS IN MY LAWSUIT. AND I DON'T
8 KNOW IF YOU READ MY REPORT OR NOT, BUT THERE WAS A DEAD
9 BIRD, A RAVEN, THAT WAS PUT ON MY DOORSTEP ABOUT THREE WEEKS
10 AGO AND I'M SUING SEVERAL SATANISTS, AND SO BECAUSE OF THAT
11 I PUT THE CONTENT OF MY WEBSITE ON SEVERAL NEWS GROUPS.

12 I DID THAT BECAUSE I WANT TO BE OUT THERE WITH
13 THE INFORMATION IN THE GENERAL PUBLIC'S VIEW FOR MY
14 PROTECTION. AND I CALLED THE POLICE; I HAVE -- I HAVE THE
15 POLICE REPORT AND PICTURES OF THIS DEAD RAVEN THAT WAS
16 PLACED ON MY DOORSTEP. SO THERE IS NOTHING THAT I AM SAYING
17 OR DOING THAT'S DIFFERENT THAN WHAT I'VE ALLEGED IN MY
18 LAWSUIT --

19 THE COURT: OKAY.

20 THE PROBATIONER: -- AND IF ANY OF THE PARTIES HAVE A
21 PROBLEM WITH THIS AND -- I WOULD THINK THE PROPER FORUM
22 WOULD BE IN FEDERAL COURT BECAUSE IF THEY'RE ALLEGING LIBEL
23 OR -- THEN THE COUNTERS IN FEDERAL COURT SEEMS TO BE TO ME
24 THE APPROPRIATE PLACE TO --

25 THE COURT: I AGREE. WHAT DO YOU WANT ME TO DO ABOUT
26 IT? I HANDLE THE CRIMINAL CASE AGAINST YOU; I DON'T HANDLE
27 ANYTHING THAT YOU THINK IS BEING DONE IN THE CIVIL WAY

4 THE PROBATIONER: I AGREE.

5 THE COURT: SO YOU'RE ON PROBATION FOR A COUPLE MORE
6 MONTHS. I UNDERSTAND YOU'RE GOING TO BE ASKED TO TAKE ONE
7 MORE POLYGRAPH AT THE EXPENSE OF THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT,
8 AND YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO COME BACK AND SEE ME ON AUGUST 8, AND
9 IF EVERYTHING CHECKS OUT, YOU ARE PRETTY MUCH DONE --

10 THE PROBATIONER: THANK YOU, SIR.

11 THE COURT: -- OKAY? OTHER THAN THAT, I DON'T REALLY
12 NEED TO HEAR FROM YOUR WITNESS.

13 THANK YOU FOR COMING.

14 THE PROBATIONER: OKAY. THANK YOU.

15 MS. SOLOV: THANK YOU, YOUR HONOR.

16 THE PROBATION OFFICER: THANK YOU.

17 THE COURT: OKAY.
