I have just learned that probation is trying to get the Internet privileges of Ms. Diana Napolis revoked.

This is quite puzzling to me and to be frank I cannot understand why anyone -- except perhaps perpetrators or perpetrator/friendly individuals -- would not welcome the courage of this outspoken advocate for children who disclose crimes involving satanic ritual abuse.

As a psychologist who has worked with several dozen adult and child victims of ritualistic crimes, I am impressed by the depth and breadth of the documentation that Ms. Napolis has made available on the Internet about the existence of satanic ritual abuse.

Would not the revocation of this woman's Internet privileges be a violation of her right to free speech?

I wonder if those who seek to silence Ms. Napolis from exposing satanic ritual crimes would be as eager to revoke her Internet privileges if her website were focused on something like gardening or dieting or even so-called "false" memory syndrome?

She should have the right to free speech on this issue, as should all involved. others, such as the organization and its website of *The Leadership Council on Child Abuse & Interpersonal Violence* at <http://www.leadershipcouncil.org/>, which addresses similar issues.

Some people who complain about websites such as Diana's should be suspect, whether they may have a graduate degree or not, or represent any "authority figures." These who complain may have hidden agendas, which is highly likely in this case.
