For as the **Father** has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself,

John 5:30

I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the **Father** who sent Me.

John 5:36-37

But I have a greater witness than John's; for the works which the **Father** has given Me to finish--the very works that I do--bear witness of Me, that the **Father** has sent Me. ³⁷And the **Father** Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I *am* with the **Father** who sent Me.

^{13:1}Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the **Father**, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

Jesus, knowing that the **Father** had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God,

John 14:6-13

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the **Father** except through Me.

⁷"If you had known Me, you would have known My **Father** also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him." ⁸Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the **Father**, and it is sufficient for us." ⁹Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the **Father**; so how can you say, 'Show us the **Father**'? ¹⁰Do you not believe that I am in the **Father**, and the **Father** in Me?
