STN Convention Closing Awards Ceremony

For the fifth year in a row, we are looking for students to act as hosts and presenters at the STN Affiliate Convention's Closing Awards Ceremony.

We will be choosing 12 students this year. To audition, students must submit a mini-dv or VHS tape of themselves reciting the short script you will find at the end of this e-mail. Please print it out. **Do NOT put this script on a teleprompter.** Students should memorize the script, or use a printed hard copy of it to refer to, just like we ask them to do at the ceremony (we do not provide a prompter there).

Ten STN Affiliate students will be selected as presenters, and two students will be chosen as the ceremony's co-hosts. No more than one student will be selected from a school.

To apply, students should submit a mini-dv tape, and include a typed sheet containing their name, school, state, teacher's name, plus their teacher's daytime phone number.

Students chosen as hosts or presenters must agree to:

- Attend a short meeting at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, January 18, at the Disneyland Hotel.
- Attend a rehearsal beginning as early as 7 a.m. on Sunday, January 20 in the Disneyland Hotel hotel.
- Dress formally for the closing ceremony.

We hope many of your students will apply. The selections will be announced no later than December 17, 2007. Postmarked deadline for submissions is December 1, 2007.
