- When:** **May 30/31, Boys U10-U19 Competitive & Boys U10 – U14 Recreational Team**
Jun 6/7 Girls U10-U19 Competitive & Girls U10-U14 Recreational Teams
There is no Rain-out Date.
- Who:** Recreational Teams U10 - U14; Competitive Teams U10 – U19.
U10 divisions 7 vs. 7 and U12-U19 divisions 11 vs.11
All players must have played in the 2008 Fall or 2009 Spring AYSO season.
- Cost:** U10 = \$400 + \$250 Referee Deposit
U12-U19=\$500 + \$250 Referee Deposit
- Where:** Fields within the City of Mission Viejo or close proximity to.
- Format:** Round robin Pool Play where all teams play 3 games; 2 on Sat and 1 on Sun. The Top 4 teams in a Flight advance for the Championship (1st/2nd) or Consolation (3rd/4th) game to be played on Sun. U10 are 2x 25 min halves and U12-U19 are 2x30 min halves.
- Awards:** 1st – 4th for each Flight. All teams receive a Tournament pin.
- T-shirts:** Provided to all players and coaches (max 2 coaches); T-shirts will also be available at the Tournament for purchase (quantities limited).
- Due Dates:** **May 1 for May30/31; May 6 for Jun 6/7** (must be rec'd by) Teams acceptance will be posted on the tournament web site within 2 days from the cutoff date of their official acceptance into the Tournament.
Teams that will not be accepted into the tournament will be notified via e-mail within 2 days from the cut of date, and they will be immediately refunded, unless they ask to be kept on the waiting list.
- Acceptance:** Teams will generally be accepted on a first come, first accepted basis and will be officially posted on the tournaments web site within 2 days of the Due Date of acceptance. Teams providing a Referee Team may receive preference. Regions will be initially limited to 2 teams per flight. Incomplete tournament packages do not hold a spot (properly completed team application and money are a minimum). The registrar will post confirm receipt of the application on the tournament website and immediately notify of any deficiencies needing correction. If the Tournament application receipt confirmation is not posted within 7 working days, please contact the registrars via e-mail at mvcregistrar@cox.net

- Payments:** Payments should be made payable to “AYSO Region 84 Mission Viejo Classic” by Regional check. Tournament fees and Referee Deposit should be combined into one check.

Profit Dist: The Tournament is planned to make a profit where all profits will be used to supplement the Region 84, Fall 2009 Mission Viejo program efforts. Region 84 has 3,000 kids participating.

Refunds: Any team that withdraws 30 calendar days prior to the event will receive a full refund. Any team that withdraws less than 30 calendar days prior to the event will receive a full refund if a replacement team is found. Otherwise the refund may be reduced for items that have been purchased for the team participating (i.e. T-Shirt, Pins). Team refunds will be mailed within 14 calendar days. If the Tournament is cancelled 30 calendar days prior to the event, full refunds will be issued to all teams.

In the unlikely event the Tournament is cancelled due to events beyond our control (less than 30 calendar days before the event), all teams will receive a full refund.

The Referee Deposit refunds will be mailed within 14 calendar days.

Teams will be refunded their Referee deposit in full if the Referee team (3 referees) completes three or more game assignments. In case the referee team completes 75% or more of their assignments, the refund will be prorated based on $\$250/9=\27.77 per referee per game. In case the referee team will complete less than 75% of their assignments, the refund will be forfeited.

Completion of referee assignments is determined by the Chief Referee or designate.

All refund checks will be made payable to the team's Region.

Definitions: **Competitive Team** – A team which selects players for participation based primarily on their ability. An example is an All Star team.

Recreational Team – A team that is most like a primary season team.

More Info: The Tournament Rules & Regulations and the Referee Plan have complete details of the Tournament.
