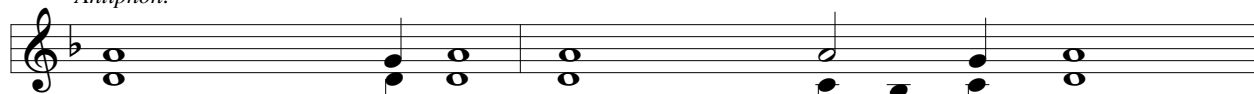

At the Washing of Feet

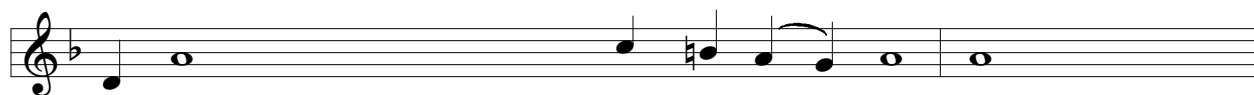
Antiphon:
