**Where are we  
NOW?**

*At this moment* we have \$420,639.29 in gifts and pledges. Of this amount we have already banked \$176,084.02. This is more than 25% of the total pledged and promised. Our campaign is having an amazing first year. As you are aware a preliminary list of work made necessary by the Fire code and the Insurance Company must be met. The finance and building committees will be meeting with several architects this month to choose the right person to accompany our work. Please feel free to write in any suggestions or questions you may have. They will be brought before the committees as necessary.

**When  
are we going to Start?**

After the Finance and Building Committee meeting last Wednesday I met on Friday for 1 ½ Hours with the Diocesan Finance Committee. We have been given the go ahead to contract with the Architect and begin with the basic work that will enable us to do the painting and repair of the Stained Glass as it should be done. These necessary works include the Church doors (5 sets), the Fire Alarm, The heating/air conditioning system and the exterior front entrance. This will all be done in consultation with the Diocesan Building Commission. We are looking to begin in the next few months.
