The web site offers some privileges that are unavailable for folks who are not members. For example, there are slide shows and member information.

To become a member all you have to do is go to the TRCoC web site at:

Click the **Members Connect** button in the top bar, followed by **Login**, & finally by clicking **Become a Member**. There is a little information that we require for membership but, of the remaining requested information, complete whatever you are comfortable with other members knowing.

Still, to be on the congregation mass mailing list, you do not have to be a member. Just send me your name and email address and I'll add you. My email address is:

Similarly, we have a text messaging service set up where we can send a text message to many subscribers at once. You do not have to be a member to on this list either. Just email me your full, 10-digit cell phone number & your service provider and I'll add your cell phone to the list. You will have to pay for text-messages we send in accordance with the contract you have with your provider. However, we will use the text messaging only for important messages from the congregational leadership or to validate that the service is working.

Also, just recently the hosting vendor for the congregational web site started offering an RSS (Really Simple Syndication) feed for information that changes frequently on the web site. If you have an interest in any of these feeds, let me know & I can help you set it up.
