May 31, 2007 at Encinitas Viewpoint Park, the Friends of the Encinitas Library donate \$100,000 to the Encinitas Library and kick off their fundraising campaign. The money was raised through years of book sales and other fundraising efforts. 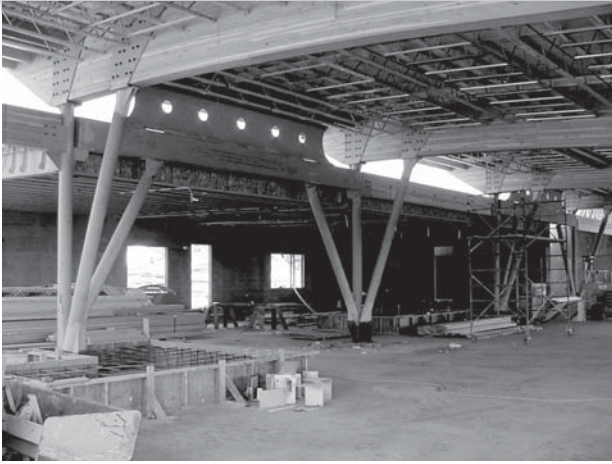
