CAMPOUT CHECKLIST—WHAT TO BRING

Parent or Guardian: The Royal Rangers Motto is "READY!" Please use this checklist to make sure your child has everything he needs to be *READY* for Campout. We suggest you mark your child's name on all items. Reminder: you need to pack enough clothes for a two day campout.

Important note: All boys' camping gear will go to the campsite ahead of time. There will be no room on the bus for your child's camping gear. So everything on this list **must** be at the church no later than the Outpost Meeting on June 3rd or your child may not be able to go on the campout. You can turn gear in to your child's commander anytime from now to the end of the meeting on the 3rd. All gear will be locked up in a safe location at the Church.

THINGS YOU NEED TO BRING:

- \$70.00 fee **must be paid by Wednesday June 3rd, 2009** (*fundraiser credit can be used*)
- Forms: Emergency Medical Release BB Gun permission Model Release
- Bible Flash Light & Extra batteries
- Bed Roll: CHOOSE Sleeping Bag Pillow Blanket Foam Pad
- Sweater or Jacket Raincoat or Poncho Baseball type Hat
- Royal Ranger Uniform or T-Shirt (*get this from Outpost Store*)

AT LEAST 1 COMPLETE CHANGES OF CLOTHES (*enough for 2 days*) SHOULD INCLUDE:

- Old Jeans T-shirts Shorts Socks Underwear Pajamas
- One *EXTRA* pair of comfortable Shoes Swimsuit (*for water slide*)
- Sunglasses Sun Block SPF30 or higher Glasses or Contacts & Kit
- PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS: Toothbrush Toothpaste Comb or Brush
- Hair Gel Soap Washcloth Towel Dirty clothes bag Tissues

OPTIONAL – BUT NICE TO HAVE:

- Pencil / Pen & Paper Pocket Knife (*Cut & Chop Card required*)
- Extra spending money (*\$10 would be a good limit*) Disposable Camera

WHAT "NOT" TO BRING:

Please do not bring any items that would detract from the camping experience. This includes no electronic toys or music devices. Don't bring anything too valuable to lose. And don't bring anything that does not belong in the hands of a Christian. Inappropriate items may be taken away to be returned to a parent after the campout.
