

## General Information

### Introduction

This brochure contains brief descriptions of tours available. Please book your excursions as soon as possible since certain shore excursions can accommodate only a limited number of participants. We recommend that you purchase them in advance of your cruise in order to avoid disappointment.

### Activity Level

The Shore Excursions presented in this brochure require the guest to use a motor coach or other forms of transportation which will require the guest to step up 2 to 3 steps, approximately 10 inches high each. Most (but not all) coaches used can accommodate collapsible wheelchairs. However, it should be noted that escorts, drivers, guides, and shipboard staff are not obliged to lift guests into the vehicles. Lift-vans and/or coaches are not available in all ports of call. Tendering may preclude guests in wheelchairs from going ashore at certain ports of call. For further information, please check with the Shore Excursion desk on board immediately upon arrival.

To assist our guests in choosing their excursions, all tours have been graded according to the level of activity they entail. Please refer to the tour symbols(s), which appear in each tour description. Kindly note the below symbols act only as a guideline and guests must make their own judgment regarding participating in tours. The symbols represent the following:

#### Mild



To fully participate may require leisurely walking over primarily even surfaces. There may be a limited number of steps, a minimal amount of cobblestones or uneven surfaces, and some standing for extended periods of time.

#### Moderate



To fully participate may require extended periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, steep terrain and/or water activity in a slight current. There may be steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and extended periods of standing. Participants with physical limitations should take this into account.

#### Strenuous



To fully participate may require extended periods of physical exertion, extensive walking, climbing, or biking. There may be numerous steps, inclines, cobblestones, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. These excursions are the most active and have been designed for participants in excellent health and very good physical condition.

#### Light Snack / Refreshment



If a light snack or refreshment is served on an excursion, it will be designated with this symbol.

#### Meals



Most tour departures complement the ship's meal service hours. If a meal is served on an excursion, it will be designated with this symbol.

#### Shopping



Time permitting, limited shopping is available during the tour.

#### Waiver



All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form. This document will be distributed by the tour operator prior to commencing the tour.

#### Xpedition



Celebrity Xpeditions™ shore excursions are once in a lifetime experiences consisting of rare opportunities, exotic locations, or special events all designed to treat you famously in ways you never imagined.

#### Restrictions

Please note there are certain excursions that for safety reasons, age, weight and/or height restrictions apply. These restrictions are imposed by the individual vendor and Celebrity Cruises, Inc. must comply accordingly.

#### Tour Availability

Please note that not all tours are available on all ships. Tour prices and itineraries are in effect at the time of printing and are subject to change without notice.

#### Weather

Most tours will operate rain or shine. However, full refunds will be made to guests holding tickets for canceled shore excursions. In the event of a tour cancellation, every effort will be made to accommodate guests on other available tours.

#### Children's Pricing

Unless indicated, children's pricing is valid for children 12 and under. Guests under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

## What To Know

**SHORE EXCURSION OFFICE:** Desk hours will be announced on board in the ships Daily Program. Normally, the office will be closed while the vessel is in port, unless otherwise stated.

**TIMES OF TOURS COMMENCEMENT** will be published on board. In the interest of all concerned, please be punctual to the meeting points. Guests wishing to travel with friends should proceed to the point of departure as indicated on your shore excursion tickets, as this will help the tour staff to allocate space in the same vehicle.

**EXCURSION TIMINGS:** Most morning tours will meet in a lounge on board the ship. When the ship is at anchor, staff will be on hand to assist you to the departure point. Timings have been established according to information received from our Agents but are subject to alterations should the vessels arrival time at the port be delayed or circumstances arise whereby the itinerary for a particular excursion must, necessarily, be amended. Kindly note that tour times provided online may be earlier than the vessels scheduled arrival to a port of call. The time listed may be in local time as provided by the tour operator. The most accurate tour departure time will be provided directly onboard the vessel. When the ship lies at anchor, guests should allow ample time for the tender ride to shore. When booking more than one tour in a day, please allow at least 60 minutes between the return of the first tour and the departure of the second tour. Tour departure times may vary from those listed on the order form, especially in ports where the ship must tender guests ashore. Please check your tour tickets for the time and location of departure. No announcements for the tours will be made on board the ship. All guests are required to be back aboard ship no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time, which is listed in the Daily Program and posted at the gangway. The scheduling of all Shore Excursions conforms to this requirement. If you leave a tour en route, it will be your responsibility to secure transportation and return to the pier on time. If for any reason a ships excursion is delayed in its return to the pier, the ship will be notified and will await the tours return.

**JOINING EXCURSIONS:** Please show your excursion ticket when coming ashore and boarding the excursion vehicle.

**SEATS** are not reserved in advance. This procedure aids the rapid departure of excursions.

**PRICES** of shore excursions are quoted per person and generally include available local transportation, ranging from coaches, taxis, limousines, and boats. Meals and local taxes are included where specified. Where tours are operated by car, 2 to 3 persons are allocated to each vehicle.

**WITHDRAWAL OF TOURS:** The right is reserved to withdraw any tour, to limit membership in any tour, or to make alterations in the operation of any tour, which may be deemed advisable for the safety or convenience of guests.

**ITINERARIES** are expected to be operated as described in the brochure but the right is reserved to change or omit a place to be visited or the sequence of the tour, in accordance with conditions or circumstances prevailing at the time of tours, with or without previous notice; bearing in mind the convenience and best interest and safety of guests. The right is also reserved to decline, to accept, or retain any person as a member of any party at any time.

**RESERVATIONS/CANCELLATIONS:** Shore Excursions are available for purchase once you are aboard the ship and en route to your destinations except where otherwise noted, within the deadline advertised in the ships daily program. Very shortly after each closing time and date, final confirmations are sent from the ship to the Agencies concerned informing them of the definite and final requirements for meals, seats, number of automobiles and coaches, etc. If notice of cancellation is received after closing date and hour, a refund can be assured only in the event of the ticket being resold. However, in the event of any of the shore excursions having to be canceled, full refund will be made and upon tendering of same Celebrity Cruises shall be free of all liability in respect thereof. The closing dates and hours for all tours will be announced in the daily issue of the ships program.

**REFUNDS:** No refunds are made to any guest who might cancel, deviate, leave, or otherwise not utilize all of the services scheduled to be provided by an excursion. Members of any excursion who elect to leave the automobiles or coaches, in the shopping area, or elsewhere, must provide their own transportation at their expense back to the landing place of the vessel. Should any such excursion, however, be abandoned through force majeure the best possible refunds will be arranged according to the circumstances. Any refund request of prepaid excursions received by Celebrity Cruises 10 days prior to sailing will be made in full. Refund requests made on board after the Shore Excursion Office closes ticket sales for that particular port will not be accommodated.

**TOURS PURCHASED ON BOARD** will be charged to your Celebrity Signature Account Card.

**GUIDE SERVICES AND TRANSPORTATION EQUIPMENT:** In certain interesting but off the beaten track places, professional guides are at a premium. The best available and obtainable guides of competence are engaged. It is exceptional for drivers of public hire vehicles to speak any language but their own. Transportation equipment used for the shore excursions is the best available in the ports of call. Air-conditioned vehicles are not always available nor do all tour buses have restroom facilities on board.

**ENTRANCE FEES:** Entrance fees to all museums and sites are included in the price of the respective shore excursions unless otherwise stated. Occasionally, a small extra charge is levied if photographs are taken, and this is not included.

**TIPS:** Tipping of any service personnel encountered on any of the shore programs is strictly optional.

**MEALS:** Most tour departure times complement the ships meal service hours, so you can enjoy your meal aboard and then go ashore. However, if you take more than one tour in a day, your return on board may not coincide with meal hours. You'll be informed of meal times before arrival in each port. Full day tours include meals where indicated.

**ALTERATION OF FARES, TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, ETC:** All prices quoted are based on tariffs and exchange rates current at the time of printing, and are subject to increase with or without previous notice consequent upon any increase in the basic tariffs and/or exchange fluctuations, which may accrue prior to commencement of the tours.

**NIGHT EXCURSIONS** vary throughout the worlds cruise ports. Many hotels have international-type acts, others national dances or folklore shows. Some ports are renowned for nightlife, while others are more conservative. We aim to take you to the most generally accepted shows for the region. Check the charges before ordering extra refreshments, photographing, or recording.

**DRESS WHILE ASHORE:** The local authorities and inhabitants of the countries visited have more conservative ideas concerning dress than you may be accustomed. So as not to offend local opinion, we would suggest that you should dress conservatively.

SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE IN ANY WAY FOR ANY DAMAGE, LOSS, INJURY OR DEATH ARISING OUT OF ANY SERVICES PROVIDED BY SUCH INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS. CELEBRITY CRUISES INC. RESPONSIBILITY DOES NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE VESSEL AND ALL ARRANGEMENTS MADE FOR OR BY THE PASSENGER FOR SHORE SIDE EXCURSIONS, TRANSPORTATION OR ACTIVITIES ARE AT THE PASSENGERS RISK.

**Terms & Conditions**

1. The Guest accepts that Celebrity Cruises Inc. (hereinafter referred to as Celebrity) acts as agent only for passengers and has no responsibility for the performance of the Shore Excursions herein specified.
2. Celebrity undertakes to use its best endeavor to ensure that a Shore Excursion is performed as advertised. However, the Passenger accepts that in certain circumstances and for reasons beyond the control of Celebrity of whatsoever kind or nature it may be impractical, unwise, or impossible for the Shore Excursion to be performed. The decision to abandon or withdraw any Shore Excursion is to be taken at the sole discretion of Celebrity but always taking into account the safety and convenience of the passenger.
3. Shore excursions are subject to cancellation or modification, depending on the number of guests participating. In the event of a tour cancellation or modification, advance notice will be given by shipboard personnel. Certain tours have a minimum booking requirement, or must be limited to a maximum number of participants.
4. The itineraries are expected by Celebrity to be as advertised, but Celebrity reserves the right to change such itineraries or to omit any place or places or to alter the advertised sequence of the excursion in accordance with the conditions and circumstances prevailing at the time of the excursion with or without previous notice. Any such change, omission, or alteration made by Celebrity shall be made at their sole discretion but always bearing in mind the safety, convenience and/or best interests of the passenger.
5. Passengers are advised to leave their baggage and all items of value on board the vessel. Celebrity accepts no responsibility for any loss of, or damage to, any such baggage, or item of value occurring during or relative to the Shore Excursion(s) specified on the face hereof.
6. Celebrity is committed to local operators in respect of reservations made. Celebrity hereof must therefore receive notice of any cancellation before the closing date and hour of the Shore Excursion(s) published, failing which a refund can only be made in the event of the ticket being resold.  
In the event, however, of the Shore Excursion(s) having to be canceled in accordance with Clause 2 hereof or for any other reason, Celebrity will refund in full the monies paid and upon tendering such refund to passengers, Celebrity shall be free of all liability in respect thereof.

## Hamilton, Bermuda

### BH1 - Scenic South Shore Highlights By Taxi

**PRICE:** ADULT: 49.00 / CHILD: 49.00 USD

**DURATION:** 3 Hours Approx.



Join your local tour guide shipside for a picturesque drive of Bermuda's famous South Shore as we head to the historic Royal Naval Dockyard.

Before arriving in the Dockyard area, your tour will include a picture stop at Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, which is alleged to be one of the oldest cast iron lighthouses in the world. The lighthouse was completed in 1846, stands 117 feet from base to lantern and the beam can be seen 40 miles out to sea. Your drive continues along the south shore where you can make a brief stop at one of the magnificent pink sand beaches. You will drive over Somerset Bridge, the smallest drawbridge in the world, first built in 1620, and then drive through the quaint Somerset Village to the Royal Naval Dockyard where your driver/guide will point out the attractions such as the Island Pottery, Art Center, Maritime Museum, and Crafts Market.

While in the Dockyard area, 30 minutes will be allocated for you to stroll and explore on your own for shopping or sightseeing before returning to the ship.

### BH2 - Aquarium, Caves & Attractions Bus Tour

**PRICE:** ADULT: 65.00 / CHILD: 48.00 USD

**DURATION:** 3 Hours Approx.



This scenic tour of beautiful Bermuda offers the island's Harrington Sound highlights by bus. The first stop will be at the Bermuda Botanical Gardens, a 36-acre park hosting a large variety of plant life. You will also pass by "Camden," the official residence of the Premier of Bermuda. Your next visit is the Museum, Aquarium, and Zoo. There you will see everything from chattering cockatoos to tiny seahorses. Over 75 species of fish, an aviary, children's touch pond, flamingos, and giant turtles all vie for your attention.

Crystal Caves is one of Bermudas most intriguing attractions. Walk down eighty-one steps, one hundred and twenty feet below the surface to the clear waters of the cave floor. Two boys searching for a lost ball discovered the caves accidentally in 1907.

Note: The steps in the cave can at times get slippery. Sensible walking shoes are recommended and caution should be taken when descending and ascending the steps.

### BH3 - Hamilton Guided Walking Tour

**DURATION:** 1 Hour 15 Minutes Approx.



Created in the 18th century by merchants and privateers, Hamilton is a bustling, business center and home to local and international interests. The City Walking Tour will highlight Bermuda's unique architecture, local history and city landmarks. The tour will conclude at a local museum brimming with local historical artifacts.

This 75-minute walking tour is conducted on fairly level terrain covering around ½ mile at a moderate pace. It is recommended that guests be in good physical condition and wear the appropriate walking attire.

**BH4 - Hamilton Trolley Train Tour**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 25.00 / CHILD: 13.00 USD

**DURATION:** 1 Hour Approx.



Board the Trolley Train for one hour of a fun, relaxing, and entertaining way to get an overview of the colorful city of Hamilton. You will drive past the famous “Birdcage,” Albouy’s Point, City Hall, the Bermuda National Gallery, the Anglican Cathedral, the Houses of Parliament, and Fort Hamilton. The drive continues to the Botanical Gardens and Camden House, the official residence of the Premier of Bermuda. Your tour returns to Hamilton and your waiting ship. During your journey the conductor will take you back in time with the rich history of the city as well as bring you up to date on the modern workings of the city.

**BH5 - Hamilton Trolley Train & Ocean Discovery Center**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 32.00 / CHILD: 16.00 USD

**DURATION:** 2 Hours Approx.



Combine a tour of the City of Hamilton and Bermuda’s newest attraction, the Ocean Discovery Center, and you have the best of both. The Bermuda Train is a fun, relaxing, and entertaining way to get an overview of the colorful city of Hamilton. After boarding the trolley, you’ll drive past the famous “Birdcage,” City Hall, the Bermuda National Gallery, the Anglican Cathedral, the Houses of Parliament, and Fort Hamilton. The drive continues to the Botanical Gardens and Camden House, the official residence of the Premier of Bermuda. The last stop is the Ocean Discovery Center at the Bermuda Underwater Exploration Institute (BUEI). There you will be guided through one of the finest shell collections in the world, unravel the intrigues of the Bermuda Triangle and wonder at artifacts on display collected by world-famous Bermudian shipwreck-hunter Teddy Tucker. You will join the search for the Elusive Giant Sea Squid. Admission to the Ocean Discovery Center is included. Once complete, you will re-board the train and finish your tour of the city en route back to the ship.

**BH6 - Bermuda Snorkeling & Glass Bottom Boat**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 52.00 / CHILD: 27.00 USD

**DURATION:** 3 Hours Approx.



This tour is aimed at families and individuals that want both the snorkeling and glass bottom boat experience. Your boat, which is one of the largest glassbottom boats in Bermuda with over 150 square feet of clear glass, departs Albouy's Point for a scenic tour of the central and western parishes. Discover, through the glass bottom, the fascinating underwater world that flourishes in the coral reefs that surround Bermuda. Next, you will have the opportunity to snorkel over an extensive reef site from the boat and to explore firsthand the exquisite and intriguing marine life. There will be complete snorkeling instruction given by qualified instructors trained in CPR and first aid. All you need to bring is your bathing suit and towel. All snorkeling equipment and buoyancy vests will be provided.

Snacks and underwater cameras are available.

**BH7 - Bermuda Glass Bottom Boat Safari**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 38.00 / CHILD: 20.00 USD

**DURATION:** 2 Hours Approx.



You'll depart from the quay as you make your way to Bermuda's “Sea Gardens.” A rainbow colored undersea world of fish and coral formations awaits discovery on this exciting voyage. En route, your Captain will show you points of interest, including the wreck of the H.M.S. Vixen. The friendly Bermudian crew will look after you with warm hospitality throughout the tour. A cash bar is available onboard.

Note: Guests must be able to walk approximately 100 yards over even surfaces with 2 – 3 steps.

**BH8 - Beach Snorkel Safari Adventure**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 54.00 / CHILD: 54.00 USD

**DURATION:** 3 Hours Approx.



If you have a quest for underwater exploration, a snorkeling adventure is the answer. While cruising to the island/beach area snorkeling instructions will be given. Instructors will be in the shallow water with you to make sure you are comfortable with your equipment, etc., and will accompany you while snorkeling. You will view colorful fish and corals around the little island. Snorkel for approximately one hour or just relax on the lovely small beach area.

You'll reboard the boat and cruise through the inner islands, relaxing and listening to a very informative, interesting commentary covering Bermuda's Fascinating past and present. Along the shoreline view some of Bermuda's most luxurious homes of the Rich and Famous such as Michael Douglas, James Martin and Anthony Quinn. This is a thoroughly entertaining cruise not to be missed.

All snorkeling equipment and life preservers /snorkeling vests are provided. Cash bar available.

**BH9 - Sail Bermuda**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 52.00 / CHILD: 52.00 USD

**DURATION:** 3 Hours Approx.



Get away from it all. Leave the hustle and bustle behind and step aboard a local sailing sloop and your Bermudian skipper will take you for a relaxing and tranquil sail through Hamilton Harbor towards the western end of the island. All you will need will be your bathing suit, towel - and your camera! During the trip, you will make a brief stop so you can swim from the boat in the crystal-clear waters in a secluded cove. Use the provided snorkeling equipment or bring your own. Enjoy a complimentary beverage on your return sail to the ship.

Please note that this is not a snorkeling tour, however snorkel equipment is available in limited quantities.

**BH10 - Restless Native Catamaran Sail, Swim & Snorkel Cruise**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 68.00 / CHILD: 58.00 USD

**DURATION:** 4 Hours Approx.



The fun begins the moment you step aboard this comfortable and spacious fifty-foot, pink sailing catamaran. Voted one of Bermudas Top Tours, this family run trip is one you wont want to miss. You can sunbathe in spacious hammocks or relax in the cozy comfort of the interior salon. As you sail through scenic harbors, your knowledgeable and friendly crew will entertain you with stories about Bermudas history, culture and geology, revealing some amazing secrets of the underwater world. You'll swim and snorkel with quality gear in a picturesque and secluded shallow water cove. This trip is perfect for anyone who likes having fun. The trip includes complimentary fruit punch, tasty rum swizzles and lots of delicious, hot home baked cookies! There is an interesting gift shop on board with lots of one-of-a-kind items. It's the perfect Bermuda day!

Please note that the onboard activities are at the guests discretion.

**BH11 - Eureka Reef Fishing**

**PRICE:** ADULT: 75.00 / CHILD: 50.00 USD

**DURATION:** 4 Hours Approx.



Come aboard the 65-foot party fishing boat "Eureka" and join your knowledgeable local Captain and crew, who will take you to some of the best fishing spots around Bermuda.

Departing from Hamilton, enjoy the panoramic views, listen to a colorful commentary, have a snack from the snack shop, or a drink from the fully licensed bar or visit Eureka's gift shop. As you arrive at your destination, the boat drops anchor and you put out your lines to the bottom. Expect some action and excitement and tight lines! You may catch snapper, triggerfish, porgies, yellowtails, grouper, chub, bonita, amberjack, barracuda and many other species. This is light tackle fishing, which is fun for all! Fishing trip is inclusive of fishing tackle and bait and instruction or assistance for novice fishermen is provided. Memorabilia photos of your party and your catch are available on board. Box lunches are available for purchase on board, or you can bring your own picnic.

The Eureka fishes in protected waters within the reef where it is usually relatively calm.

Please note that due to regulations, fish are not allowed to be brought back on board the cruise ship.

**BH12 - Famous Homes & Hideaways Cruise**

**DURATION:** 1 Hour 30 Minutes Approx.



This is undoubtedly the best way to see Bermuda while cruising the beautiful inshore waters. You will embark on a leisurely sightseeing tour that is fully narrated. As we cruise along the shoreline viewing the charming colonial style homes painted in pastel colors we will see homes of the Rich and Famous such as Michael Douglas, James Martin and Anthony Quinn to name a few.

Cruise through the small islands of Paradise Lakes with Bermuda Longtails flying overhead and turtles swimming below. Learn about the habitats and history of these beautiful island hideaways, only accessible by boat. The memory of the cruise and pleasant staff will stay with you long after you leave their beautiful shores.

**BH13 - Cruise & Kayak Eco Tour**

Fantasea's Cruise & Kayak Eco-Tour is a fantastic way to gain insight into Bermuda's fascinating history and explore the island's interesting marine ecosystem. Following a short boat tour to the launch site, you will board a stable sit-on-top kayak for a fun and easy introduction to the sport of paddling. After your practice session, enjoy a guided kayak tour through the "Paradise Lakes" area, a beautiful sheltered waterway surrounded by over a dozen historic islands; or the Daniel's Head area, a scenic eco-reserve in Bermuda's West end. Both areas are home to an interesting collection of plants, birds, and marine life. The kayak guides will provide an informative commentary and the occasional paddling tip as the tour winds through hidden coves and inlets, before culminating at a quiet backwater or beach. There will be time to enjoy a refreshing swim and relax with complimentary beverages prior to your return trip. Wear a swimsuit, and don't forget your towel, sunscreen, and hat.

All minors must be accompanied by an adult in order to participate.

Participants need to be capable of 30-40 minutes of continuous, moderate exercise. Persons with restricted upper body mobility should not participate in this tour. Guests must be able to walk approximately 100 yards over even surfaces with 2 - 3 steps to reach the pier.

**BH14 - Catamaran Coral Reef Snorkel**

Your tour begins as you board the comfortable and stable "Aristocat" for a trip to the northernmost coral reefs in the world. Relax on deck and enjoy complimentary soft drinks while our crew provides an informative commentary on the island and the fascinating undersea ecosystem.

After an approximately 45 minute cruise you will find yourself moored in a deep blue oasis, bordered by fringe reef on nearly all sides. This tour just may be one of the highlights of your stay in Bermuda. These new glass bottom kayaks are a fantastic way to view the beautiful underwater world of corals and fish. Not only will you be able to see the reefs and fish clearly, but also you will feel safe and secure, as these special kayaks are extremely stable, easy to handle and dry.

After boarding the kayaks either from a beach in waist deep water or the boat, you'll be instructed on the techniques of kayaking. You will then paddle along the shoreline made up of lagoons and fascinating rock formations at a relaxed pace for approximately one hour. Along the way one will usually see herons, Bermuda Longtails and other different types of birds depending on the time of the season. As you paddle quite often the water is calm and clear enough to see colorful coral reef and fish. You will also pass some of Bermuda's forts, which date back to the 1600s. Your Bermudian tour guide will provide you with information about the island's endemic flora, history and marine eco-system.

The tour ends with a swim or if you prefer just, relaxing on the boat. Complimentary bottled water as well as a safety vest is provided. Tour is approximately 2 ½ hours long with 45 minutes of kayaking. The tour will go to the best site depending on weather conditions.

Please note that the kayaks are two-seaters and have a maximum weight limit of 400 lbs. Please Wear a bathing suit and bring a towel.

As you drive back through St. George, your driver/guide will point out additional places of interest.

After anchoring in waist-deep water, which provides the easiest and safest access to the water and beach for either shallow or deep water snorkeling, there is a complete professional instruction offered. The instructors provide a complete snorkeling lesson and will swim with you should you need assistance in any way. You may explore the area independently or swim with one of the guides as they point out the different marine life, identifying the abundant fish, coral, and plant life. In addition to snorkeling, you can explore the island or the beautiful beach.

Your snorkeling equipment, buoyancy aids, safety vest, professional instruction, supervision, and transportation are all included. A cash bar is available on board during the return trip. Light packaged snacks are also available.

Your tour begins and ends with a thrilling ride on our famous military style R.I.B. boat that shuttles guests to and from the Dive Boat which is waiting at our reef location. Once onboard, a comprehensive pre-dive briefing with particular emphasis on safety and tips to help maximize your Helmet Dive experience is given. Every dive is led by a fully qualified instructor who will ensure your Helmet Diving experience is the highlight of your visit to Bermuda.

While underwater your host will give you a guided tour of a world inhabited by exotic sponges and fascinating corals. You will be encouraged to hand feed the myriad of tropical fish that show up on a daily basis to view the strange underwater guests! Imagine experiencing all of this without even getting your hair wet! Guests should wear a swimsuit, sunglasses, plenty of sunscreen, and bring a towel.

Basic flotation aids are available but we do not recommend this tour to non-swimmers. Cold beverages are available for sale on board and the boat is 70% shaded.
