Dan Alon began fencing when he was 12 and dreamed of competing in the Olympics. In 1972, then aged 27, Alon marched into the Olympic stadium in Munich under the Israeli flag. "I was in heaven," he said. "It was the most beautiful day of my life." Six days later, on Sept. 5, 1972, the Palestinian terrorist organization Black September took 11 Israeli athletes and coaches hostage in their rooms at the Olympic Village. None of the hostages survived, including his coach, Andre Spitzer. Listen as Dan speaks for the first time about his experience at the Munich Olympics 1972.
