Enclosed are the rules for the kids race and the parents race. Please note that there are differences in the rules. For the kids race, please keep in mind the following points: (1) the car cannot weight more than 5 oz.; (2) the wheels must be nailed in (no axles); and (3) the official Greater Cleveland Council rules must be followed if you wish to participate at the District Race on April 29th, which will be held at Fairchild Chevrolet in Westlake. For a fee, parents may also sponsor their own car at the Friends of Scouting Pinewood Derby event on Friday, April 28th at Fairchild Chevrolet.
