Frederick Franklin Fangrow went by the name Frank. According to Thomas Franklin Fangrow Sr., Frank was 5 years old when his father Martin fell off the roof of a house and died. Frank thought he was the only heir, but Corinne (and a brother?) came in and split the estate. Frank's grandmother Johnson (Elizabeth Johnston) is buried nearby in a plot purchased by Frank. He had her moved from another cemetery. Frank sold newspapers in Kansas City, Missouri when he was 8 or 9 years old. He also lived in Arkansas for a time with his Aunt Josie.

According to Ellis Island records, Giovanni Ingrasciotta arrived in the United States on April 22, 1914 aboard the San Guglielmo, a steam ship from the port of Palermo, Sicily. The ship's manifest lists him as a single male of 16. He was not able to read or write English. His occupation is "Laborer". The name of the nearest relative was listed as his father, Domenico Ingrasciotta, who lived in Castelvetro. His final destination was Kansas City Missouri, where he had a brother named Salvatore living at 104 S. [E?] [5?] St. He had a ticket to his final destination that he paid for himself. He was 5'3" tall, with a fair complexion(sic), brown hair and brown eyes.

If he was 16 years old in April of 1914, he was born in February of 1898, or September of 1897.

The Social Security Death Index states his birth date is September 28, 1896

The Missouri Certificate of Death states his birth date is February 26, 1899

His Passport (Number 2090178) states his birth date is February 26, 1897

State of Kansas v.s. Edward Wilson and Harry Arnold  
(notes by S. R. Cole, Justice of the Peace)

On the 23rd day of October 1895 Martin Fangrow filed this complaint that the above defendants did brake(sic) in his house and there from take and carry away some articles of clothing - and Martin Fangrow swore out a warrant for said defendants. Geo. W. Elliott arrested said defendants and brought them before me a J. P. On examination - Martin Fangrow swore that it was reported to him one 1/2 mile from his home that some person or persons had robbed his house - when he started and [tracked?] some persons west and some campers by the road side told him that 2 boys had passed going west carrying a -sack- or bundle- then Martin Fangrow went on to Holliday and waited and saw the 2 boys Edward Wilson and Harry Arnold. He arrested them and turned them over to Constable Elliott. Fangrow says the boys had his clothes on when he arrested them.

Mrs. Julia Dixon sworn and says - She owns the farm and lives in the house where plaintiffs clothes was taken from, and after dinner on the 23rd day of Oct. she locked and fastened all doors and went to the grocery store one mile off - and she say(sic) 2 boys sitting by the road side eating a lunch and they laughed at her - and when she returned and unlocked the front door - she saw all her papers, Deeds, etc. scattered over the floor and the back door open and she sent word to Mr. Fangrow - while she gathered up the papers and saw that the clothes was gone as they had been in the same [press?] with papers and the [press?] door open - She

identified Edward Wilson and Harry Arnold as the 2 boys sitting and eating by the road side as she went to store. George Strasser sworn says that he could identify the clothes as the ones belonging to Fangrow.

Warrant issued and read to Edward Wilson and Harry Arnold who said they was not guilty of house breaking - but did take the clothes - Defendants not being able to give \$100 bond for their appearance on the 25th day of Oct. - I, S. R. Cole, J. P., confined them to the county jail for the 25th day of Oct. 1895. Geo. W. Elliott Dept. Sheriff brought prisoners into [court?] when on the above evidence they was bound over [under?] \$500.00 for their appearance in the District Court of Johnson County at the January term in 1896 - and committed to the county jail of Johnson County Kansas to await until court convened.

Edward Wilson and Harry Arnold denied breaking in house. They said they went to the well to get a drink - then went to back door to ask for something to eat and the door stood wide open. They knocked, received no reply went to middle door knocked again and that door swung open - seeing no one they went in and opened the cubbard and [press?] door and saw the clothes and that their own clothes being badly dilapidated they took said clothes, put them in a sack and went west about one mile and put on the clothes, putting their old ones in the sack - and then went on west to Holliday where Fangrow arrested them - they acknowledge sitting by the road side eating when Mrs. Julia Dixon passed.

I certify the above to be a correct transcript of the above case.

The boys took 2 cloth coats worth \$3.00 each, 2 pairs of trousers worth \$3.00 each, 2 cloth vests, 2 cloth shirts worth \$0.75 each, one revolver worth \$0.50, aggregate value \$13.25. The total amount of the legal fees was \$29.75. The jury found Harry Arnold not guilty. The jury found Edward Wilson guilty of larceny in a dwelling house, and found him not guilty of burglary.

1900 Census - Martin Fangrow, 38, Son, born in Kansas Apr. 1862, Single, father born in Germany, mother born in Pennsylvania, Day Laborer, unemployed 6 months that year.

1901 Marriage - Martin Fangrow & Cora Jackson, both of Wyandotte County, were issued a marriage liscense on July 1, 1901 in Leavenworth, Kansas, as reported in the Western Life Newspaper.

1905 Census - Marten Fangrow, 43, born in Kansas, Farmer. Also Cora, 22, and F. F., 3, male. In the Agriculture Schedule of that year, Martine Fangrow owned 45 acres of improved land with 180 rods of hedge and 120 rods of wire fence. Farm was worth \$2000, plus \$1000 in buildings and \$100 in implements. He had 13 acres of winter wheat, 15 acres of corn, 2 acres of Irish potatoes, and 300 bushels of corn. He also had 1 acre of Timothy and 5 acres of uncultivated pasture under fence. The family had 100 lb. of home-made butter, 3 horses, 2 milch(sic) cows, 6 swine, and 1 dog.

According to Thomas Franklin Fangrow Sr., Martin died by falling off the roof of a house. His son, Frederick Franklin Fangrow was about 5 years old at the time. This puts Martin's death about 1906.

Notes for Cora Johnson:

1900 Census - Cora and Josephine Johnson are living with Jesse and Annie Fourtner. Jesse and Annie have been married 4 years. The rented house is on West Twelvth Street, Kansas City, Missouri. Annie, 20, is the older sister of Cora, 17, and Josephine, age 14. Josephine is "At School", Cora works at "Cleaner Dye Shop" (but unemployed 6 months), and Annie has no occupation listed. Jesse is occupied as "Carpenter". He was born in Illinois, and both of his parents were born in Kentucky. The girls' Father was born in Scotland, and their Mother in Kentucky.

The July 4, 1901 edition of the Western Life Newspaper, published in Leavenworth, Kansas,says:

"A marriage liscense was issued Monday to Martin Fangrow, aged 38, and Cora Jackson, aged 18, both of Wyandotte County." According to Thomas Franklin Fangrow Sr., Cora's maiden name was Johnson. He said Cora's sister lived with Martin and Cora. The 1905 Shawnee census shows a Josephine Johnson living in the same house. After Martin died, Cora moved to Missouri and married Tom Conboy.

According to Marie Anntionette Engrasciotta, he was very mean. He would mark the loaf of bread before leaving the house, and if any was missing when he returned, he would beat his wife. He later killed a man with a butcher knife and went to jail.

Notes for Maria Antonia Ciaravello:

According to Marie Anntionette Engrasciotta, Maria Ciaravello was the mother of Josephine by her first husband, Luigi Avellino. When Josephine was 5 years old, they went back to Italy, then returned some time later. She then married Mr. Desimone.

She had a baby on one of the voyages. The baby died, so they named the ship after the baby. The ship was on its maiden voyage and had not been named.

1920 Census - Kansas City, Missouri. Mary Avelyns, 39, Widowed, head of household, born in Italy, not able to read or write. Also Tom, 20, unable to read or write; Josie, 16, attends school, can read and write; Rocco, 4. The whole family was naturalized in 1911.
