

Crew fares well

The U of C Coed Crew Club made an impressive showing last Saturday as it took a first, a second and a third out of the five events it entered at the Chicago Spring Regatta.

The Women's Novice Four finished first in its race in a "really encouraging" race, according to David Glaser, president of the Coed Crew Club. It was the third race of the day for the four women who had earlier competed in the Women's Open Four and in the Mixed Eight.

The Men's Novice Four placed second in its event. The men and women members combined to win the bronze medal in the Mixed Eight event.

Five other crews representing Michigan State, Milwaukee Boat Club, Mendota Boat Club, Lincoln Park Boat Club, and Ecorse also competed in the regatta sponsored by the mayor's office.

"We thought we did pretty well," said Glaser. "We had a lot of fun."

The Coed Crew Club will not compete in a major race again until the fall, according to Glaser. However, the club's Learn To Row program is full swing with about 30 novice rowers participating.
