The Trees Are Coming!

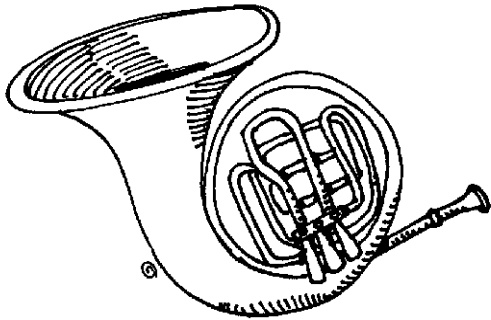

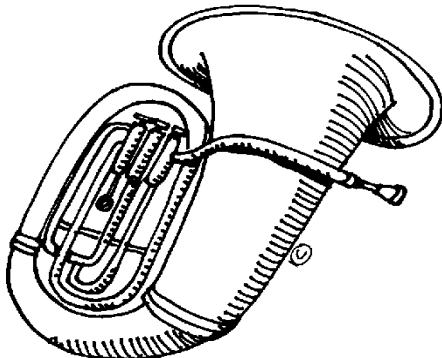
Are you interested in membership in the Afro-American Historical and Genealogical Society or the U.S. Colored Troops (Civil War) Institute?
