Directions: 

The Avon-Lions Community cabin is on 2155 Eaton road in Avon across from the Northgate Park.

From the east or west, take I-90 to the route 611 exit. Exit south bound onto 611 this is Colorado Avenue. At .9 mile from the exit turn left onto Carleen then bare left onto Eaton Road. The Cabin is on

the right across from the Northgate Park.

From the south use Rt. Rt.83 North, turn left onto Detroit Rd.8mi turn right onto Colorado Rd. go .4mi. north and turn right onto Carleen then bare left onto Eaton. The Cabin is on the right across from the Northgate Park.
