

Chipola River



Jacobs Road Bridge

Access: From US 90 in Marianna, FL, turn north on Jefferson St. and drive 1.2 miles to the intersection of Caverns Road. Bear right on Caverns Road and drive 1.8 miles to the intersection of Old US Road (CR-167). Bear left on Old US Road and drive 4.2 miles to the intersection of Jacob Road (CR-162). Turn left onto Jacob Road and drive 2.6 miles to the Chipola River Bridge. Access to the water is at the SW end of the bridge. Launching can be a very muddy affair following a high water event.

Florida Caverns Canoe Launch

Access: From US 90 in Marianna, FL, turn north on Jefferson St. and drive 1.2 miles to the intersection of Caverns Road. Bear right on Caverns Road and continue 0.9 miles to the intersection of State Cavern Road which is the entrance to the Caverns Park. Follow State Cavern Road 0.9 miles to Fish Hatchery Road. Turn right onto Fish Hatchery Road and continue 0.9 miles to the launch site. This is the point where the Chipola River goes underground.
