

Conecuh River



~250 yds. upstream from US 29 McGowan Bridge

Access: From the intersection of Hwy 87/CR-191 in Milton, FL, drive north on Hwy 87, which becomes AL Hwy 41 when you cross the state line, for 33.2 miles to the intersection of US 29 in East Brewton, AL. . Turn right onto US 29 and continue 18.7 miles to the east end of the Conecuh River McGowan Bridge. After crossing the bridge take the first left onto a side lane doubles back toward the bridge. Drive about 100 yards to where a small narrow lane turns to the right into the woods. Turn right and continue on to the parking area which is approximately 0.2 miles from the highway. Access to the water is via a cut in the high sand bank leading down to the waters edge..

Mancil Rock Landing

Access: From the intersection of Hwy 87/CR-191 in Milton, FL, drive north on Hwy 87, which becomes AL Hwy 41 when you cross the state line, for 33.2 miles to the intersection of US 29 in East Brewton, AL. . Turn right onto US 29 and continue 16.1 miles to the intersection of Mancil Rock Road. Turn right onto unpaved Mancil Rock and continue 1.3 miles to the landing.
