

Murder Creek



Kirkland Bridge

Access: From the intersection of US31 and US29 in Brewton, AL, drive NE on US31 4.1 miles to the intersection of Old Castleberry Road. Turn right onto Old Castleberry and continue 0.6 miles to the intersection of Sybil Lane. Bear right on Sybil and continue 0.2 miles to the intersection of Martin Luther King Drive. Turn left onto MLK and continue 2.0 miles to Murder Creek Road. Turn right onto Murder Creek and continue 0.5 miles to the Kirkland Bridge. Access to the water is at the NE end of the bridge. The access lane down to the water has very deep ruts near water. N31 11.511 W87 01.584

Fort Crawford Park

Access: From the intersection of US31 and US29 in Brewton, AL, drive E on US29 0.5 miles to the intersection of Snowden St. Turn left onto Snowden and continue 0.4 miles to Fort Crawford Park Drive. Turn left onto Fort Crawford and continue 0.4 miles to the Park. Access to the water is at the far end of the Park. Four wheel drive vehicles can drive out onto the sandbar next to the water. Others will have to carry their boats approximately 75 yards to the water's edge. N31 06.225 W87 03.386
