

Perdido River



Barrineau Park Bridge

Access: From the intersection of US 29 and Muscogee Road (CR-184) in Cantonment, FL, drive north on US 29 5.4 miles to the intersection of CR-196. Turn left onto CR-196 and continue 3.2 miles to the intersection of CR-97. Turn north on CR-97 and continue 2.4 miles to the intersection of CR-99. Continue straight ahead on the unpaved road for 0.4 miles to the Perdido River Bridge. Access to the water is on the SW end of the bridge.

Parking: “No Parking” signs have been posted at both ends of the bridge. **Escambia County Sheriffs Dept is issuing tickets** even when parked past the last “No Parking” signs.

The Pipes Landing

Access: From the intersection of US 29 and Muscogee Road (CR-184) in Cantonment, FL, drive west on Muscogee Road 2.6 miles to the intersection of CR-97 and Hwy 112. Bear right onto CR-97 and continue 3.0 miles to the intersection of Old Bridge Road. Turn left onto Old Bridge and continue 0.4 miles. The pavement ends at an unpaved single lane road. Follow this road 0.7 miles to the landing. Just before reaching the landing parking area you must cross a small stream stabilized with large stones. If you feel unsafe crossing the stream there is a small parking area a little way back where you can park.

Muscogee Adventures Unlimited Canoe Livery

Access: From the intersection of US 29 and Muscogee Road (CR-184) in Cantonment, FL, turn left onto Muscogee Road and continue 4.8 miles to the intersection of River Annex Road on the right. Turn right onto River Annex and continue 0.5 miles to Adventures Unlimited on the left. N30 36.320 W87 23.843

Parking: Paid parking is located on both sides of the road. Expect to be crowded on weekends and holidays.

Fee for use: Yes, \$5.00 to park plus \$2.00 per boat to launch/takeout

Sand Landing

Access: From Interstate 10, Fla exit 5, drive west on Alt US 90 (Alt US 90 will merge with US 90) 5.6 miles to the intersection of the Perdido River Water Management Area access road located directly across from the Florida Weigh Station. Turn right on the access road and continue 0.9 miles on the gravel road to the intersection of Sand Landing access road identified by a sign. Turn left onto the Sand Landing road and continue 0.2 miles to the landing. Access to the water is via a paved boat ramp. N30 32.261 W87 26.400

Parking: Parking for several vehicles, May be crowded with fishermen on weekends and holidays.

Nature Conservancy Lane Landing

Access: From Interstate 10, Fla exit 5, drive west on Alt US 90 (Alt US 90 will merge with US 90) 6.4 miles to the intersection of the Perdido River Water Management Area Nature Conservancy access road located on the left side of the road N30 31.422 W87 26.299. The sign at the entrance is difficult to spot when traveling west. Turn left on the gravel access road and continue ~ 0.1 miles to a locked gate. If you have permission to enter continue straight ahead on a single lane unpaved road for ~1.8 miles to Lane Landing on the right. Park only in the designated area. N30 29.996 W87 25.870 **Caution: The road to the Landing may be difficult to navigate after heavy rains.**

Parking: Parking for several vehicles. At the present time the Conservancy area **is not open** to the general public.

Facilities: Yes, restrooms at the entrance gate. Two sheltered areas at the landing. A paved boat ramp.

Security: Locked entrance gate.
