

Pigeon Creek



US 84 Pigeon Creek Bridge

Access: From the intersection of Hwy 87/CR-191 in Milton, FL, drive north on Hwy 87, which becomes AL Hwy 41 when you cross the state line, for 33.2 miles to the intersection of US 29 in East Brewton, AL.

Turn right onto US 29 and continue 18.4 miles to the intersection of Brooklyn Road (CR-43).

Turn left onto Brooklyn and continue 7.2 miles to the intersection of CR-6.

Turn right onto CR-6 and continue 0.3 miles to the intersection of CR-42.

Turn left onto CR-42 and continue 0.4 miles to the intersection of CR-43.

Turn right onto CR-43 and continue 10.3 miles to the intersection of CR-93.

Turn right on CR-93 and continue 1.8 miles to the intersection of US 84.

Turn right onto US 84 and continue 4.5 miles to the Pigeon Creek Bridge.

Access to the creek is from the NE or SE end of the bridge.

CR-107 Pigeon Creek Bridge

Access: From the intersection of Hwy 87/CR-191 in Milton, FL, drive north on Hwy 87, which becomes AL Hwy 41 when you cross the state line, for 33.2 miles to the intersection of US 29 in East Brewton, AL..

Turn right onto US 29 and continue 18.4 miles to the intersection of Brooklyn Road (CR-43).

Turn left onto Brooklyn and continue 7.2 miles to the intersection of CR-6.

Turn right onto CR-6 and continue 0.3 miles to the intersection of CR-42.

Turn left onto CR-42 and continue 0.4 miles to the intersection of CR-43.

Turn right onto CR-43 and continue 10.3 miles to the intersection of CR-93.

Turn right on CR-93 and continue 1.8 miles to the intersection of US 84.

Turn right onto US 84 and continue 7.6 miles to the intersection of CR-7.

Turn left onto CR-7 and continue 2.3 miles to the intersection of CR-107.

Turn left onto CR-107 and continue 1.5 miles to the intersection of Hwy 55.

Turn left onto Hwy 55 and continue 1.4 miles to the intersection of CR-107 on the right side of the highway.

Bear right onto CR-107 and continue 4.2 miles to the bridge. Access to the Creek is from the SW end of the bridge N31.28.610 W86 39.522

A sign at the CR-107 intersection warns that the Pigeon Creek Bridge is closed. Another sign about half way to the bridge warns of a 3 ton limit on the bridge. Local traffic uses the bridge so use your own discretion. If in doubt, you can continue down Hwy 55, cross the Hwy 55 Pigeon Creek Bridge, turn right onto CR-107 where it merges back into Hwy 55, and approach the bridge from the west.
