

Styx River



CR-64 Bridge

Access: From the intersection of Alabama I10, exit 53, (aka Wilcox Exit) drive north on CR-64 0.9 miles

to the north end of CR-64 bridge. Vehicle access to the river is on the northwest end of the bridge. If vehicle access is not possible because of water you must park along the highway and portage your boat approximately 100 yards down the east side of the bridge. It would be safe to assume you will have to portage. N30 38.508 W87 36.674

Parking: Limited parking space along the highway right of way at the north end of the bridge. A road single lane trail at the northwest end of the bridge leads back to the water but a mud hole about half way down to the river will be filled with water after a rain. Expect site to be crowded on weekends and holidays.

CR-87 Bridge

Access: From the intersection of Alabama I10, exit 53, (aka Wilcox Exit) drive north on CR64 1.2 miles to the intersection of unpaved Linholm Road on the right. Turn right onto Linholm and continue 3.9 miles to the intersection of CR-87. Turn right onto CR-87 and continue 2.3 miles to the north end of CR-87 Bridge. Vehicle access from the northwest end of the bridge is blocked. Access on the northeast end of the bridge is possible with a high clearance 4 wheel drive vehicles. Otherwise, portage to the river at the closest point is approximately 100 yards along the northeast side of the bridge. N30 36.347 W87 32.821
