

Yellow River



Hwy 55 Yellow River Watkins Bridge

Access: From Interstate 10, exit 45, west of Holt, FL, drive north 1.0 miles to the intersection of US 90. Turn right onto US 90 and continue 2.6 miles to the intersection of Galliver Cutoff Road. Turn left onto Gallivar Cutoff and continue 4.5 miles to the intersection of Hwy 4. Turn left onto Hwy 4 and continue 10.5 miles to the intersection of CR-2. Turn right onto CR-2 and continue 5.5 miles to the intersection of CR-602. Turn left onto CR-602 and continue 1.9 miles to the intersection of Old Ebenezer Road. Take hard left onto Old Ebenezer and continue 3.5 miles to the intersection of Walker Road. Turn right onto Walker and continue 0.5 miles to the intersection of New Ebenezer Road. Turn left onto New Ebenezer and continue 1.9 miles to the intersection of CR-4. Turn right onto CR-4 and continue 1.2 miles to the intersection of CR-20. Turn left on CR-20 and continue 7.6 miles to the intersection of Hwy 55. Turn left onto Hwy 55 and continue 1.6 miles to Yellow River Watkins Bridge. The water access trail is approximately 0.3 miles passed the river on the left side of the road. The trail to the river parallels the highway back to the launch site on the SW end of the bridge. The trail is not maintained and is pitted with some very deep depressions. Low clearance vehicles may not be able to negotiate the trail all the way back to the river launch site. Access: From Interstate 10, exit 45, west of Holt, FL, drive north 1.0 miles to the intersection of US 90. Turn right onto US 90 and continue 2.6 miles to the intersection of Galliver Cutoff Road. Turn left onto Gallivar Cutoff and continue 4.5 miles to the intersection of Hwy 4. Turn left onto Hwy 4 and continue 10.5 miles to the intersection of CR-2. Turn right onto CR-2 and continue 4.9 miles to the Tyner Bridge. Access to the river is at the NE end of the bridge. N30 55.510 W86 33.542

Access: From Interstate 10, exit 31, east of Milton, FL, drive south on Hwy 87 4.2 miles to the entrance to the Yellow River Bridge boat ramp. The entrance is on the left side of the road. Turn left and double back to the ramp. Access to the river is at the SE end of the bridge.

Little Gin Hole Landing

Access: From Interstate 10, exit 56, at Crestview, FL, drive south on Hwy 85 3.0 miles to the intersection of Rattlesnake Bluff Road (RR211). Turn right onto Rattlesnake Bluff and continue 4.8 miles to the entrance road on the right leading to the Little Gin Hole Recreation Area. Turn right onto the entrance road and continue 0.4 miles to the Parking area. Access to the water is via a paved boat ramp. N30 40.811 W86 39.055
