

Notice to Paddlers
11/15/09

- **The Beaver Creek Bridge (N30 48.508 W86 46.766) on Beaver Creek/Barton Road is reported by Greg Pack, Nov 14, 2009, to be closed again. About ½ of the bridge is gone.**
- Eglin Reservation Personal Recreational Permits have increased from \$10 to \$12 per year. For more information call 850-882-4164 or 850-882-4165.
- Perdido River from Barrineau Park Bridge to Muscogee Adventures Unlimited is free of log jams.
- **Warning to paddlers!** Even if you park beyond the “No Parking” signs at the Barrineau Park Bridge Escambia County Sheriffs Office will issue you a ticket. Alabama has extended the no parking signs farther west on their side of the bridge.
- Due to lack of funding the USGS 02374250 Conecuh River gage at State Hwy 41 near Brewton AL. will be discontinued effective Oct. 1, 2009.
- The Northwest Florida Water Management District Fillingim Landing approximately 3 river miles below the Barrineau Park Bridge is nearing completion.
- The Northwest Florida Water Management District is planning to open a camping facility at Otto Landing approximately .8 miles below The Pipes Landing on the Perdido River sometime in the spring of 2010. This will be a limited access facility.
- **Styx River, 5.1 miles above Seminole Boat Ramp, is block by a log jam at least 100 ft in length. Jam coordinates N30 32.324 W87 29.758. There does not appear to be a portage route around the jam.**
